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The Stones of St. Andrew's, Shrivenham By Neil B. Maw (Shrivenham Heritage Society)

In the Winter of 2022 – 23, a project to tidy up the graveyard of St Andrew's Churchyard, Shrivenham, was undertaken by the Church Wardens and Volunteers. It was a formidable task, as much of the vegetation had grown into sizeable trees, some of which had completely engulfed numerous tombs and gravestones. Co-incidentally but at the same time, Neil Maw of Shrivenham Heritage Society had been experimenting with methods of transcribing weathered, lichen infested memorial stones. It was logical then, that the two ideas should run together and that as the stones were cleared, they could be photographed and transcribed.

An idea was then formed of putting the information to good use. It was suggested by the benefice administration that many enquiries are received from members of the general public who are researching their family ancestry, and a list of all the names recorded on stones in the churchyard would be of great help. In the light of what was discovered during the winter survey, some of the members of Shrivenham Heritage Society, determined to produce a small book that would contain an index of surnames, first names, the year of burial and area location within the churchyard. The book would also contain photographs of the most notable stones that represent the general chronology of late 17th century to mid 20th. All of the photographs of individual stones and transcriptions would be stored in the society's digital vault and be made accessible to all researchers.


During the process of recording the stones, it was realised that there were many stones that had once been standing, were systematically laid down, made tidy and had subsequently been overgrown by grass and weeds. Some of these were positioned in neat rows and some were single stones. It was determined by the date of the stones and by historical photographs that the laying down process must have occurred at least a century previous. Among the stones uncovered are some superb examples from the 17th century. Research has determined that gravestone markers did not become fashionable until the 17th century, was slow to become popular and certainly not affordable by all. These early stones are typically small when compared to those from 18th and 19th century, and it's likely that some will have fallen down within a few years of being erected and overgrown. This might explain the extraordinarily good preservation of their engravings. A general survey of other churchyards in the neighbourhood, (above ground) have nothing to equal the quality of those at St Andrews.

Whilst this small book is not intended to be a history of the church it may be as well to point out the possible age of the churchyard. Stylistically the central tower of the church could have been built as early as 1300AD and there exists reliable documentary evidence of the names of Vicars of Shrivenham from as early as 1250AD. We can only assume that the church was located where it is now and that the size of the churchyard has remained fairly constant over that period. If another assumption is made that at least five people per year have been buried there, then by the year 1600 approximately 1500 burials would have occurred. There are just under 900 burials represented by the stones examined during this recent survey and if several hundred were added to represent unmarked burials, it would mean that the churchyard, regarded as full by circa 1950, has been so twice. Many mediaeval remains must have been disturbed during the second phase of use, and one is perhaps to wonder if somewhere close by there lies a Charnel House, a depository for disturbed bones. A survey of the graveyard was commissioned by the Vale of White Horse District Council in March 2004. (See copy below). It was a detailed survey in that all the upright stones were included. However, it made no allowance for the stones that were laid flat and overgrown, some for well over a century. Please note - we have made no attempt to match the numbers on this map with the actual stones. We were also able to confirm that some of those stones had been moved. In consideration of that, and giving thought to the future, we have decided to divide the graveyard up into seven areas. The approximate centre of each area has been printed on the map in two corners. As time progresses, all of the stones will erode, crumble, fall and it's likely that the whole area will become a grass garden of remembrance. Researchers will be able to discover in what part of the graveyard their ancestors lie from the grid reference, but not the exact spot. However, future advances in technology may enable detection of skeletal remains and be able to extract DNA without disturbing them. From us here in the year 2023, we pass on our greetings to you in whatever century you are hopefully still reading this, perhaps with that technology.

We have published this small book that contains an index of names, the year of burial/death and the area number within the graveyard. If the person you are searching for is in the index, please email us on the address inside the front cover stating who you are and the nature of your interest. You will be sent a link to the file that contains photos of the stone, and a transcription of the text it contains. You may download the photos and use as you wish, but if for publication, please credit Shrivenham Heritage Society. 

















The Memorial stone of Amariah Fairthorne whose family owned and occupied the Manor House just over the other side of the churchyard wall through the 19th century. (Now demolished)





The Fairthornes are the highest number of occupants in the graveyard with 29 in total. They came to the area from Lambourn in the latter part of the 16th century with William Fairthorne occupying a farm and mill, to become known as Tuckmill in Watchfield in 1600. They became wealthy, yeoman class landowners.

The Dod family were from the Yeoman class of Shrivenham in the late 17th & early 18th centuries and were associated with the Manor House and the land that belonged to it in the north. Ann was baptised on 14th June 1687, so lived only two years.

Beneath lies the ashes of William Hoare. Changed to stone by Smallpox. Distinguished in his intellect. Proclaimed after death. Died February AD 1722 Many of the photographs of the gravestones in this book are white in appearance. This is caused by the technique of using flour after the stone has been brushed, in order to enhance the engraving. On stones that are encrusted with lichens it is particularly useful as an aid to transcribing the wording; it also makes for a clearer photographic image. The flour is simply brushed off afterwards and dissolves harmlessly into the soil.
